NOTE: There is a \$20 jury of admissions fee for first-time exhibitors and Exhibitors returning after an absence of two or more years.

All exhibitors must furnish the show with a New York State Sales Tax ID-DTF-17. To apply on line, see directions given via the link on the left side of our website's home page www.wsoae.org – or call 518 485 6800 and ask for Form DTF-17, DTF-17, publication 750.

- Exhibitors must agree to report and pay necessary taxes. including New York's 8.875% sales tax.
- ✓ All parking must be legal and strict sanitation regulations must be observed.
- ✓ All booths and their contents must be furnished by the exhibitor. You will need:
- **1** A free-standing rack. Booth spaces are approximately 10 running feet by 4 1/2 feet. up to 10 feet in depth, depending on the width of the sidewalk. The height limitation is approximately 8 feet.
- 2 Your own chairs, tables, display equipment, hanging supplies, etc.


NOTE: Umbrellas and canopies are permitted as long as they do not carry corporate logos or promotional messages. No generators are permitted.
