WSOAE juries for awards <u>RAIN OR SHINE</u> on Saturday and Sunday of the opening weekend. Awards are made in every category of fine arts and crafts. We encourage all show participants to submit a work for prize consideration. Among other things, the awards highlight to the public the quality of work in our show and, in the aggregate, involve thousands of dollars in prize money. In celebration of our 80th anniversary year (2010), the Board has increased to \$1,000 The Best in Show Prize.

BRINGING IN YOUR WORK

On the opening Saturday of the show, <u>RAIN OR SHINE</u>, when you check in with your monitor at 9 a.m., he/she will give you a packet containing the jury card. This card must be filled out and attached to the piece of work that you will be submitting for jurying. Please make sure that the card is attached securely to your piece.

You will then bring your work to the Salmagundi Club, 47^{th} Fifth Avenue, between 11^{th} and 12^{th} Streets. The time for everyone to bring in their work will be from 9:30 a.m. to 12 noon. No work will be accepted after 12 noon.

PICKING UP YOUR WORK

Your work must be picked up at the Salmagundi Club, 47 Fifth Avenue, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 12 noon, <u>RAIN OR SHINE</u>, on Sunday, the second day of the opening weekend. Your work must be picked up on Sunday morning, as the Salmagundi Club will be closing in the early afternoon

due to the Monday holiday and will not re-open till Tuesday morning. Any work not picked up will be subject to handling and shipping charges.

Prizes are announced Sunday morning., and checks are subsequently mailed to the winners. If your art wins a prize, we ask that you leave it on display for the duration of the show (even if it is sold during the show) as this is really the only way the public can view it.
